### Batteries swallowed by young children

#### Date of report: 30 July 1997

There was a total of 303 cases in the Injury Surveillance Information System (ISIS) in which a child, aged 0-9 years, swallowed a battery.

#### About ISIS:

ISIS is a national collection of hospital emergency department attendance records. Over 50 hospitals and other medical centres have provided data to the collection over the period 1986-1994. It should be stressed however that the ISIS collection does not provide a comprehensive coverage of all injuries presenting to hospitals in Australia. Nonetheless, the collection is large (over 700,000 records) and can provide a good description of the circumstances leading to specific types of injury, as well as identify less common injury occurrences. Information about injury circumstances is usually self-reported by the injured person. Additional clinical information is provided by the treating medical staff.

#### Disclaimer

This is a brief analysis written in response to a specific question from one of the Centre's clients. It uses available data and should not be viewed as a detailed piece of research. The Centre releases this information in the interests of ensuring that work done for one client can inform others. The report must not be quoted or cited without written permission from the Centre.

Cases were selected using the following criteria: all cases involving children 0 to 9 years of age in which a 'BATTERY' (including wet cell battery) was coded as being a factor in causing the injury; where the mechanism of injury was coded as either 'INGESTION'; 'FOREIGN BODY IN'; 'INHALED' or 'OBSTRUCTED BY' and where the affected body part was consistent with a battery having been swallowed (ie cases in which a foreign body had been inserted into the ear or nose were excluded). These search criteria yielded a total of 303 cases.

In brief, these patterns were observable from the analyses undertaken:

- As would be expected, the greatest proportion (80.5%) involved children under the age of 5 years. More surprising, was the frequency of cases involving children between 5 and 9 years of age whose level of development would lead one to expect such events to be very rare.
- Most commonly, the injuries occurred whilst children were playing.
- Poisoning was a common outcome of swallowing batteries (43.9%).
- More than half of the cases (52.8%) required a significant level of treatment, and 10.9% were admitted to hospital.
- The batteries swallowed by children came from a diverse range of products including hearing aids, calculators, video games, remote controls, singing birthday cards, etc.

### **Explanation of some codes used in ISIS**

## The Interdependence of Breakdown, Mechanism and the Factor Codes

At the heart of the multifaceted structure that is the ISIS database, lies the combination of up to six codes that become interdependent in telling the story of each injury event, viz:-

Breakdown event	tells us HOW things went wrong to precipitate the entire accident or injury sequence (VERB)
Breakdown factors	tell us WHAT (thing or person) went wrong (SUBJECT)
Mechanism	tells us HOW the injuries were caused (VERB)
Mechanism factors	tell us WHAT caused the injuries (SUBJECT). Most of the rest of the data relates to the victim (OBJECT)

Consider the case of the child who opens mother's handbag, left unattended on the lounge, and, having opened it, then proceeds to consume the packet of sleeping tablets inside.

Breakdown event	tablets left in a dangerous position (Code # 12)
Breakdown factors	MOTHER! (the tablets didn't go wrong, and both the handbag and the child appear to have operated to normal expectations! (Code # 6503)
Mechanism	ingestion (Code # 31)
Mechanism factors	the tablets (Code # 192?)

Now consider an almost identical circumstance; just add the information that the tablets were stored inside an allegedly child-proof container; whilst the Mechanism and mechanism Factors remain unchanged, the Breakdown event now becomes a product failure and the Breakdown factor is now the childproof container that wasn't.
