Validata™ is ready to receive June 2023 extracts

If your May 2023 extract has been submitted to Validata™, you can now upload and submit your June 2023 extract. Please remember to submit your extract once it has been validated and contains zero critical errors.



Data cut-off date for 2022-23 annual report

The cut-off date for agencies to load extracts for inclusion in the Annual Statistical Summaries is Monday 7 August 2023. To continue the high submission rates achieved in previous reports, please ensure all extracts for the period July 2022 to June 2023 are uploaded and submitted to Validata[™] by this deadline.



Changes to Telstra Top Ups program

Since 2019 SHS agencies have been able to use SHIP to access free credit for Telstra pre-paid mobiles for their clients. The Telstra Top Ups program is a partnership between Infoxchange and Telstra that enables SHIP users to request and activate the credit on behalf of their clients.

Telstra have been running the program to help people experiencing homelessness, domestic and family violence or natural disasters stay connected in times of crisis.

From the 4th of July, the following changes will come into effect in SHIP:

- Top up amount: \$160
- Maximum number of Top ups: one top up per unique person per financial year

SHIP Address search

Did you know that you can search for a client in SHIP by their address? The address is derived from the Primary Details page within a client's record, in SHIP.



When searching for a client by their address you can utilise the Search By > Address option within the Persons page, in SHIP.

	Tip: If you are not sure about the spelling try only using the first few letters. For example, 'rich' could return Richlands, Richmond and Mount Richmond				

Methods to search for a client include searching by:

- ✓ Street and suburb
- ✓ Street
- ✓ Suburb✓ Current addresses (default) by checking the "current address" box
- ✓ Prior addresses by un-checking the "current address" box.

You can also use the "%" (wildcard) and the initial letters of a street name when running a search for a client.
