AODTS NMDS reporting options for AOD agencies

Does the AOD agency receive funding through the Commonwealth **Drug and Alcohol Program (DAP)** or solely funded through a **Primary Health Network (PHN)**?

→ <u>No</u>

State/territory funding only

If an AOD agency only receives funding from a state/territory they must report directly to their state/territory health authority

Combination funding

If an AOD agency receives funding from a state/territory and from the Commonwealth or a PHN, they can either report (1) directly to the state/territory health authority or (2) via their contracted AOD organisation (membership required)

Commonwealth funding only or solely funded by PHN

If an AOD agency only receives funding from the Commonwealth (DAP) or a PHN; they can either report (1) directly to the AIHW or (2) via their contracted AOD organisation (membership required)

State/territory health authority

The state/territory will provide final data to the AIHW for reporting

AOD contracted organisation

The AOD contracted organisation will provide agency data directly to the state/territory or in some instances the AIHW (e.g. QNADA, NADA)

AIHW

The AIHW analyse and report on AODTS NMDS
