3 FTE nursing staff in hospitals, 1997–98

The annual Australian public hospitals data collection by the Australian Institute of Health and Welfare includes full-time equivalent (FTE) staffing numbers in nursing and various other categories. Data relating to private hospitals are taken from the ABS publication *Private Hospitals* 1997–98 (ABS 1999).

Public hospitals

In public hospitals (acute and psychiatric) between 1995–96 and 1997–98 there was an increase in FTE nursing staff per available bed from 1.35 to 1.40. However, staffing per bed, per 1,000 separations and per 1,000 patient days varied significantly among the States and Territories in 1997–98. The three largest States had at or slightly below the national provision of 4.7 FTE nurses per 1,000 patient days. The five smallest States and the two Territories had a significantly higher provision – between 5.0 and 5.4 FTE nurses per 1,000 patient days.

During the period from 1995–96 to 1997–98 changes in patient statistics and staffing in Australia included the following.

- A 5.0% increase in separations and a 6.1% increase in patient days.
- A 14.4% increase in same day separations.
- A decline in overall staffing of 5.1%, including a 2.9% decline in nurse staffing from 80,570 FTE nurses to 78,239 FTE nurses.
- Separations per FTE nurse increased by 8.1% and patient days per FTE nurse increased by 9.3%.

Private hospitals

Private hospitals (acute and psychiatric) contrast with public hospitals in the trends in their patient statistics and staffing levels. During the period from 1995–96 to 1997–98 changes in patient statistics and staffing in private hospitals in Australia included the following.

- A 9.2% increase in separations and a 0.2% increase in patient days.
- An increase in overall staffing of 6.3%, including a 6.2% increase in nurse staffing from 23,136 FTE nurses to 24,567 FTE nurses.
- Separations per FTE nurse increased by 2.8% and patient days per FTE nurse declined by 5.6%.

However, in 1997–98 the staffing level of one FTE nurse per 64.5 patient separations in private hospitals was significantly lower than the public hospital staffing level of one FTE nurse per 48.2 patient separations. This is largely associated with the substantial differences in the patients treated in terms of their nursing care requirements. Detailed statistics on the demographic, diagnosis and medical procedure characteristics of patients in public and private hospitals are presented in *Australian Hospital Statistics* 1997–98 (AIHW 1999).

Private fee-standing day hospitals experienced strong growth in both patient and staffing numbers from 1995–96 to 1997–98. There was a 30.1% increase in patient separations and a 39.9% increase in FTE nursing staff to 696.
