Validata™ is ready to receive August 2023 extracts

If your July 2023 extract has been submitted to Validata™, you can now upload and submit your August 2023 extract. Please remember to submit your extract once it has been validated and contains zero critical errors.



Annual SHS Statistical Summary reports

The 2022-23 annual snapshot has been successfully taken. The national submission rates were 100% for July 2022 - April 2023 & 99.9% for May and June 2023. Thank you everyone for another great result.

Annual 2022-23 SHS Statistical Summary reports will be available to download from Validata[™] in early September 2023. You can access these reports in Validata[™] by logging in and selecting the 'Reports' tab. How to complete the Labour force status question

In the SHS collection, 'Labour force status' is only collected for clients aged 15 and over. Therefore, the only valid response for clients aged <u>under 15</u> is 'Not applicable'. This aligns with the Australian Bureau of Statistics Labour Force standards.

For clients aged 15 and over, 'Labour force status' should be collected and a response of 'Not applicable' will generate an error. See the error below, as displayed in SHIP.



Refer to the definitions below to help you complete 'Labour force status' correctly for clients aged 15 and over:

Employed: The client was working in the past week or had a job but was not at work that week.

Unemployed: The client was actively looking for full-time or part-time work.

Not in the labour force: The client was not employed and not actively looking for work. This may include some students, clients keeping house (unpaid), retirees and those permanently unable to work or in institutions.
