

6 Employed nurses, national nursing labour force survey, 1996

Overall numbers

- In 1996 there were 218,172 nurses employed mainly in nursing, of whom 171,684 were registered nurses and 46,488 enrolled nurses.

Main areas of practice

- Of the 197,458 registered and enrolled nurses employed as clinicians, 64,054 (32.4%), were employed in the areas of medical and surgical practice, 38,272 (19.4%) in gerontology/geriatric nursing, and 14,642 (7.4%) in obstetrics, gynaecology and midwifery.
- The distribution across specific areas of clinical nursing was similar across all States of Australia. In the Australian Capital Territory and the Northern Territory, which have younger populations than the rest of Australia, the percentages of nurse clinicians employed in gerontology/geriatrics (13.0% and 7.3% respectively) were lower than in the States, and higher than the States in midwifery (12.0% and 12.4% respectively). The Northern Territory had a high percentage (14.1%) of nurse clinicians employed in community health compared with 2.8% nationally.

Age

- The average age of all employed nurses was 39.9 years, the highest since this survey commenced in 1993. The average for females (40.0 years) was slightly older than that for males (38.4 years).

Hours worked

- Employed nurses worked an average of 32.9 hours per week, with males averaging 39.6 hours per week and females averaged 32.3 hours. 51.7% of females worked less than 35 hours per week compared with only 17.5% of males.

Country of birth and initial qualification

- In those States for which the data were available (New South Wales, Queensland, Western Australia and South Australia), 76.2% of nurses employed in 1996 were born in Australia. A further 11.2% were born in the United Kingdom or Ireland, 3.9% in Asian countries, 2.8% in New Zealand, 2.5% in 'Other Europe' and 3.3% in other countries.
- 87.9% of employed nurses gained their initial nursing qualification in Australia, with 0.7% qualifying in the United Kingdom or Ireland, 1.9% in New Zealand, 1.8% in Asia and 7.7% in other countries.

Citizenship

- 92.9% of employed nurses were Australian citizens. Nurses employed in Tasmania and the Australian Capital Territory had the highest percentages of nurses who were Australian citizens (both 94.5%) while Western Australia (89.5%) had the lowest.
